

Recognition of Prior Certificated and Experiential Learning (RPCL/RPEL) and Credit Transfer.

You may be able to use credit from previous study, transfer of credit from current study or relevant experiences towards your studies at Leeds Conservatoire. Prior learning can either be formally certificated (RPCL), credit transfer or can be a portfolio of evidence of experiences that have previously been undertaken (RPEL).

Leeds Conservatoire recognise two situations where prior learning is recognised:

1. For entry at the beginning of a course
2. For entry with exemptions from specific modules or to a later stage of the course.

Making your application

The admissions team will be able to provide advice as to what documentation would need to be submitted for an RPCL/Credit transfer or RPEL submission

Documents required for RPCL/Credit transfer submissions may include:

- Qualification(s) studied for/awarded
- Awarding institution/examining body
- Dates of your studies
- A breakdown of all units/modules/subjects taken with your grade/mark for each one.
- Module/unit descriptors with learning outcomes.

Documents required for RPEL submissions may include:

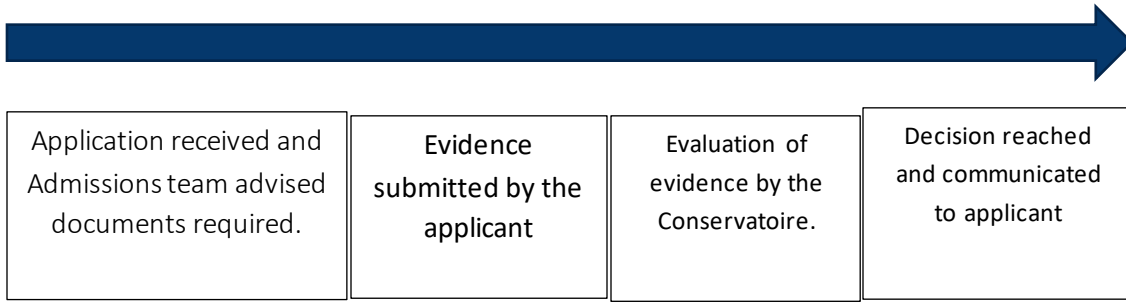
- Detailed CV outlining non-academic achievements/experience
- Statement outlining how you consider your experience has prepared you for your chosen course in lieu of the published academic entry requirements

If you have an official transcript, please include this with your application.

You may be asked to provide further information at a later point and any costs incurred obtaining transcripts or similar is the applicants responsibility.
