

LEEDS CONSERVATOIRE POSTGRADUATE PROGRESSION SCHOLARSHIP



For the 2026/27 academic year

15 scholarships are available to alumni who have an offer of a place on a taught on-site MA course at Leeds Conservatoire and belong to one or more of our underrepresented groups, will be automatically awarded a 10% discount on tuition fees. This is an additional 10% discount to your alumni discount, which means you will receive a total of 20% discount on the full price of your course.

Who is eligible?

Essential - all recipients must:

- Have an offer of a place on a taught, on-site MA degree
- Be UK-domiciled and eligible to pay home fees
- Hold an Undergraduate qualification from Leeds Conservatoire (or Leeds College of Music) at a grade of 2:1 or higher
- Have '**Firmly accepted**' your offer of study by Sunday 31 August 2026

Additional – all recipients must also belong to one or more of the following groups:

- Have a household income of less than £42,875. *The definition of household income is the same as that used by Student Finance England for undergraduate applicants who are under the age of 25. Applicants who will be under the age of 25 on 1st September 2026 must be able to provide a copy of their Student Finance entitlement letter for the last year of their undergraduate study. For applicants who will be over the age of 25 on 1st September 2025, this will be determined by the taxable income of the student and their partner/spouse, if applicable, for the tax year 2024-2025.*
- Identify as a member of the global majority or an ethnically diverse community
- Have a disability or neurodivergent/mental health/long-term health condition
- Be a mature student. *The definition for mature students at postgraduate level is aged 25 or above on the 1 September of the year they commence study.*

How do I apply?

Applicants can apply for this scholarship when applications open in the Spring. The application form will be available on our Postgraduate Scholarships & Bursaries page. **The deadline for applications for 2026 entry is Sunday 31st August 2026, at 11.59PM.**

How much does the scholarship cover?

The scholarship varies in amount by course, but each scholarship will be worth 10% of the full course fee. Below sets out the full cost of the course, the total discount you receive and the final fee of your course cost with the discount applied.
